Persist in intercession. (Hebrews 10:19-24)

Avoiding hindrances by:

- Waiting on God. (Psalm 62:1; 40:1)
- Having no presumptions. (Psalm 25:5; Isaiah 55:8-9)
- Having reverent fear of the Lord. (Psalm 123:2; 37:9)
